Subj: SPECIAL DUTY ASSIGNMENT PAY (SDAP)

1. Per references (a) through (d), this policy memorandum cancels reference (e), and establishes the Fiscal Year 2004 (FY-04) SDAP Plan effective 1 November 2003. This memorandum is directive in nature and applies to SDAP levels for both USN and TAR personnel. Specific policy guidance associated with this plan, as well as assignments authorized to receive SDAP, are contained below. Commands and servicing PSDs are responsible for administering all applicable changes to SDAP in accordance with references (a) through (d) and this memorandum.

2. The new SDAP rates that are in effect and that are to be implemented per the direction contained in reference (b) are as follows:

- a. SD-1-\$75
- b. SD-2-\$150
- c. SD-3-\$225
- d. SD-4-\$300
- e. SD-5-\$375
- f. SD-6-\$450

3. Increases in SDAP are effective as of 1 November 2003; however, SDAP reductions will not take effect until 1 February 2004. SDAP terminations will also take effect on 1 February

Subj: SPECIAL DUTY ASSIGNMENT PAY (SDAP)

2004 and will continue at half rate for one year from the effective date of termination. Eligibility for continued pay as pertaining to reductions and terminations is contingent upon the member maintaining eligibility and remaining in the billet in which the SDAP was either reduced or terminated. Permanent Change of Station (PCS) or Temporary Additional Duty (TAD) transfer into a billet designated for reduction or termination, after the effective date of the FY-04 plan, precludes eligibility for SDAP at the old level even if the member is transferred from another SDA billet.

4. References (c) and (d) govern policy and procedures for administration and payment of SDAP.

5. Unless otherwise stated in the notes, personnel may not receive SDAP while assigned in excess of authorized billets. Commands must review their Activity Manning Document (AMD)/Enlisted Distribution and Verification Report (EDVR) to ensure that the number of personnel receiving SDAP does not exceed the number of authorized billets for that skill. Service members are only authorized to receive one SDAP entitlement.

6. Commands holding SDAP billets are reminded that annual re-certification begins 1 April as directed by references (c) and (d). The deadline for annual re-certification is 31 August. Guidance for the process will be announced via NAVADMIN.

7. This memorandum reflects the Enlisted Community Managers (ECM) code responsible for each SDA skill. Refer skill specific questions to the appropriate ECM. 
b. As the Engineering Department Master Chief (EDMC) or the Reactor Department Master Chief (RDMC) onboard a nuclear power warship. Specific approval must be obtained from N133D for member to be eligible for this level of pay. During periods of turnover the incumbent EDMC/RDMC will maintain this level until relieved. Once relieved, the member will be entitled to SD-5-375 while serving onboard. N133D point of contact is EMCM(SW) Demerchant at (703) 695-3301/DSN 225.

Subj: SPECIAL DUTY ASSIGNMENT PAY (SDAP)

64. While serving in any 335X, 336X, 338X, or 339X billet (except 33X9). Personnel who are in excess of assigned billets in the engineering or reactor departments of a nuclear powered warship, the repair department of a nuclear-repair-capable Intermediate Maintenance Activity (IMA), staff of a Nuclear Pipeline Training Activity, or assigned to a Department of Energy (DOE) Naval Reactors Facility are entitled to the appropriate level of SDAP.

65. NECS 3359 and 3389 are assigned to members who are not currently eligible for assignment to a billet that involves the operation, maintenance, or supervision associated with naval nuclear power.
