1. **TAD Opportunity:** The Department of the Navy is required to provide one Navy or Marine Corps O-3 attorney to support the "Task Force on Sexual Harassment and Violence at the Military Service Academies," formed recently by the Department of Defense pursuant to Public Law 108-136. This Task Force has been charged with assessing and making recommendations concerning how the Departments of the Army and Navy may more effectively address matters relating to sexual harrassment and violence at the United States Military Academy and the United States Naval Academy (including any recommended changes in law). The report date is immediate, and the location is the Washington, DC area. The assignment will last for the duration of the Task Force's mission, which will not exceed 18 months, but is expected to last for 6-9 months. Some previous exposure to the Naval Academy as a staff member or student would be beneficial, but is not required. Interested officers should contact LCDR Jim Protin as soon as possible.
